

General Library Policies

Having access to the use of the library is a privilege, and not a right. All persons using the library will, out of Christian courtesy and consideration for others, maintain a level of quietness conducive to researching and studying. Therefore, adherence to the following rules and regulations is essential:

- No food or drinks will be allowed in the library.
- Library users are expected to work as quietly as possible in order to maintain an environment conducive to learning.
- Cell phones should be turned off or set to vibrate.
- The library's telephone is a business line and is not available for patrons unless there is an emergency.
- Computers and printers are available in the library for academic use only
- Do not shelve library books. The librarians will shelve all books.
